Item 2021/11: Call for a General Assembly, quorum and the agenda

Decision

Item 2021/12: Status report of SIOS

Decision

Item 2021/13: Strategy and work plans 2022

Decision

The vision: "We will be the leading long-term observing system in the Arctic to serve Earth system science and society" is approved.

The strategy is approved with following comments:

- Streamline the document concerning the use of 'management' and 'sustainability and communication'
- Joint activities Strategic objectives:
 - Add SIOS core data into the strategic objectives as part of #1 or extra point
 - #2: add 'environmental' before footprint
 - #3: rewrite to make it clearer; define 'science cases' in the document;
 - #4: change to 'Science cases in form of high quality science to be published in open access journals'
- Services strategic objectives
 - Change to
 - #1: Increase the visibility, accessibility and usability of all data collected through SIOS
 - #2: Provide easy and comprehensive access to all SIOS data through the SIOS Data Management System, especially the SIOS core data
 - #3: The SIOS Data Management System is the main place to find Syalbard related ESS data.
 - #4: Complement the observational data with remote sensing data from satellites, thus also reducing the environmental footprint of data collection.
 - #5: Facilitate the access to logistical services and support the work for more standardised solutions
 - #6: Further reduction of the environmental footprint through sharing of logistics and observational infrastructure access
 - #7: Provide opportunities to develop the observing system through a SIOS science wheel call (campaigns, workshops, access, etc.)
- Management strategic objectives
 - o Change to:
 - #1: Maintain a steady portfolio of externally funded projects to support the SIOS Knowledge Centre and SIOS members
 - #2: SIOS will become a key Arctic RI in the European landscape of RIs
 - #3: clarify better: "SIOS is actively present in SAON"
 - #4: Add an objective on communication (taken from the SIOS communication strategy)
 - #5: Deliver RI and data that will make SIOS a relevant resource for climate adaptation and mitigation.

The work plans for SIOS-KC and the working groups are approved with following comment:

 The work plans are good and ambitious but feasible with the help of all the SIOS member institutions
